Food Allergy: The Scale of the Problem



1 child in every class in every school in the UK has a food allergy (up to 8% of children) ¹



Developing at any age, food allergies impact a whole family's food choices – it is not a lifestyle choice and not food intolerance

2-3 million people in the UK with one food allergy or more (up to 2% of adults) 1



615% increase in A&E admissions due to anaphylaxis 1992-2012 ²



A food allergen can act like a deadly poison to someone with a food allergy – any amount Food allergies are a major public health concern

Natasha's Foundation is the only charity in the UK dedicated to funding allergy medical research.

Funding research into prevention, cause and treatments to eradicate food allergy.
